# **Aquatics Diver Technician Position**

#### Description

This professional will assist in Aquatics daily Shows, artistic rehearsals and Pool related maintenance operations. Reporting to the Carpentry Head of Department and Lead Technical Aquatics to assist the dive team in their roles of maintaining an established underwater show and running cue tracks related to prop movement, performer support and safety. Effectively inspecting and maintaining pool related systems and all aquatics related equipment.

#### **Roles and responsibilities**

- Maintain safe and consistent operations for show rehearsals and performances;
- Perform show cue tracks, and organize their teams assigned cue tracks.
- Maintain and oversee the enforcement safe diving practices;
- Work with novice divers and performers until they feel comfortable working in a water environment;
- Participate and eventually lead La Perle Theatrical SCUBA program theory and practical classes to Theatrical SCUBA trainees;
- Responsible for the outfitting of their assigned dive team members, and ensure their team has the tools/equipment necessary to complete their assigned task;
- Maintain and manage their dive teams assigned show and department specific equipment;
- Provide feedback to the Lead Aquatics and Head of Department regarding their individual team members performance;
- Participates in the Aquatics maintenance program, conducting regular inspections of all pool systems and any possible required underwater repair.
- Required to perform regular inspections of all SCUBA equipment and the Hookah underwater breathing system;
- Required to participate in regular drills and safety/medical related trainings exercises;
- Attend meetings, training activities, courses and all other work-related activities as required;
- Other tasks as assigned by La Pearl Technical Direction, Carpentry HOD or Lead Aquatics.

## Support

- Assist in inspecting, assembling and maintaining all aspects of equipment for training, rehearsals, performances, and special events; maintain all dive gear;
- Participate and supervise in pre-set, performance, and post-set of show equipment;
- Assist the Lead Aquatics and Head of Department in reaching and maintaining the Aquatic departments mission;
- Support their assigned team in safe execution of their duties;
- Support the management by implementing company policies.

# Competencies

- Ability to perform lifesaving skills and water rescue extraction, acting as First Aid/CPR responder;
- Ability to stay calm and calm others in emergency situations;
- Must have proven leadership and coaching skills;
- Ability to work in confined spaces;
- Must possess problem solving skills and strong interpersonal skills with proven talents in safety and teamwork;
- Must have excellent verbal communication skills;
- Ability to work extended hours, nights and week-ends;
- Ability to withstand long exposure to highly chlorinated water environment;

- Ability to keep excellent physical fitness;
- Ability to work under pressure.

- High school diploma or equivalent; Any technical field formal education is preferred;
- Valid Professional level diving certification with a minimum of Divemaster level for recreational diving. **Professional Dive Instructor rating or above is highly preferred;**
- Valid First Aid/CPR certification or/and lifesaving certification (EFR, DAN, American Red Cross) or equivalent.

## Experience

- Minimum 4 years experience in professional level SCUBA diving;
- Minimum 2 years working in a theater environment.

## **Other Skills**

- Must be fluent in the English language;
- Ability to read and write English in order to understand and interpret written procedures;
- Knowledge of MS Windows and MS office systems;
- Knowledge in Scuba diving equipment maintenance and repairs;
