Position Summary:

- Offer backstage coverage and emergency response during live performances and rehearsals/trainings.
- Conduct functional assessments, screenings, and prehab sessions tailored to performance needs.
- Collaborate with coaches, stage management, and artistic teams to ensure safe performance conditions.
- Maintain accurate and confidential medical documentation using internal systems.
- Contribute to department development, educational sessions, and data tracking.

- DHA License/Eligibility for Physiotherapist
