We are looking for a skilled and motivated Physiotherapist to join our team. Reporting operationally to the Head Physiotherapist and the Resident Artistic Director; You will work as show crew being responsible of safety of the performers during the show.

Roles and responsibilities

- Assess, diagnose, and treat musculoskeletal conditions related to performing arts.
- Develop individualized rehabilitation programs for La Perle artists.
- Provide hands-on physiotherapy treatments (manual therapy and exercise prescription)
- Work closely with other healthcare professionals, including doctors and coaches.
- Maintain accurate and up-to-date injury/treatment records.
- Stay current with advances in physiotherapy techniques and practices
- Under the guidance of the Head Therapist and Artistic Director, help ensure the department's daily operational needs are met while delivering the highest possible standard of care.
- Maintain a high level of professionalism and ethics with co-workers, artists, and other health care professionals;
- Actively collaborate with Performance and Wellness team and Coaches in establishing and implementing programs directed at the prevention of injury relevant to an artists' specific challenges (using various exercise approaches);
- Accompany artists to medical appointments when indicated, for the purpose of artist/show support while ensuring all necessary legal/ insurance documents are being obtained, properly communicated and filed;
- Communicate with and support the Artistic Director, Head Therapist,

Coaches and Stage Management on the functional status of artists under your care;

- Ensure that the workspace is properly and professionally organized and maintained;
- Coordinate with other Departments, Technical Directors and Stage Management for the running of performances and rehearsals
