Job Overview

Working under the Head of Carpentry, the swing technician is responsible for providing technical support across different departments during live performances, ensuring seamless execution of carpentry, sound, lighting and rigging. They must be adaptable and skilled in multiple areas of stagecraft.

Key Responsibilities

- Technical Support: Assist with the operation of carpentry, audio, lighting and rigging for performances and events.
- Equipment Management: Oversee the care and maintenance of all technical equipment, ensuring everything is in proper working order before and during shows.
- Problem Solving: Quickly troubleshoot technical issues that may arise during live events, making real-time adjustments as needed.
- Collaboration: Work closely with stage managers, directors, and other technicians to ensure that all technical aspects meet the artistic vision.
- Flexibility: Be prepared to shift between different roles as needed, adapting to various technical requirements throughout the production.

<u>Qualifications</u>

- Experience: Previous experience in sound, lighting, carpentry and rigging is preferred.
- Communication: Strong communication skills to effectively collaborate with other team members and convey technical requirements.
- Attention to Detail: Must be detail-oriented and capable of managing multiple tasks in a fast-paced environment.
- Physical Requirements: Ability to lift heavy equipment and work in various physical conditions, including heights.



Working Conditions

Swing Technicians typically work irregular hours, including evenings and weekends, as needed for performances.
